Sermon Notes Prescribed for Chronic Outrage

As outrage surges to the forefront, grace and truth fade to the background.

Christ Jesus is the base and essence of my peace. But am I at peace? Do I incite harmony and tranquility?

A few conditions that obstruct serenity:
I'm not peaceful because I'm fearful.

We're not in harmony because we're estranged.

Tranquility is absent because hostility present.

What do these verses have in common?

God was pleased to reconcile us to himself... by making peace through Christ's blood, shed on the cross. Colossians 1:19

In Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. He himself is our peace... Ephesians 2:13-14

3 relational dimensions:

peace with God... invincible peace

peace with yourself... inner tranquility

peace with others... interpersonal harmony

peace to you from God our Father spiritual peace

peace with God thru our Lord Jesus legal peace

the peace of God relational, emotional peace
