### Sermon Notes Manly Tears

Tears in a Bottle #6  
Luke 19:28-44

As he approached Jerusalem and saw the city, he wept over it and said, “If you... had only known on this day what would bring you peace—but now it is hidden from your eyes. Luke 19:41-42

1. Jesus wept as a patriot who saw beyond current prosperity to coming devastation.

Am I so absorbed in making the best I can of life, that I'm turning a blind eye to what comes after?

Am I missing the Messiah who has come among us to give a deliverance that lasts forever in the eternal Kingdom?

2. Jesus wept as a prophet / preacher who saw through religious facades to the corruption of hearts.

3. Jesus wept as the Savior who saw past the mirage of easy victory to the price of real redemption.
